## Authorized Use of School-Owned Materials or Equipment

School equipment may be loaned to individuals and/or community groups for educational, civic or charitable purposes when:

- 1. The individual or group borrowing the equipment agrees to accept responsibility for repairing or replacing any equipment damaged or lost while in its possession.
- 2. The equipment is not unusually expensive and subject to easy damage.
- 3. The equipment is in good condition.
- 4. The individual or group will provide a competent operator for any machine loaned.
- 5. Outside use of the equipment will not interfere with the school program.

Any student or other individual borrowing school equipment may be asked to sign an official receipt. A deposit may be required as determined by the superintendent or designee.

School buses shall not be lent or released to private individuals or groups, except as specified in policy EEAFB\*.
