Bus Safety Program

The school district shall comply with all state and federal laws and Colorado Department of Education regulations pertaining to the operation of school buses and shall make these requirements known to bus drivers. It also shall cooperate with local safety officials in formulating and accomplishing its school bus safety program.

Suspension of bus service

When, in the opinion of the superintendent or designee, weather or conditions of roads makes operations of buses impractical or dangerous, school bus service may be temporarily suspended. Transported pupils may be sent home early when road or weather conditions make such actions necessary.
