Staff Personal Security and Safety

Offenses against school employees

The following procedures shall be followed in instances of assault, disorderly conduct, harassment, knowingly false allegation of child abuse, or alleged criminal offense under the "Colorado Criminal Code" by a student directed towards a teacher or school employee.

These same procedures shall be followed in instances of damage by a student to the personal property of a teacher or school employee occurring on school district premises.

- 1. The teacher or employee shall file an incident report with the building principal, the superintendent's office and the Board of Education.
- 2. The principal shall, after receipt of the complaint and proof deemed adequate by the principal, suspend the student for up to 5 days in accordance with established procedures.
- 3. The superintendent may initiate procedures for the further suspension or expulsion of the student.
- 4. The superintendent or designee shall report the incident to the district attorney or the appropriate local law enforcement agency or officer who shall be requested, upon receiving the report, to investigate the incident or determine the appropriateness of filing criminal charges or initiating delinquency proceedings.

Communication of disciplinary information

The principal or designee shall communicate discipline information concerning any student enrolled in the district to all teachers and counselors who have direct contact with that student. Any teacher or counselor who is assigned a student with known serious behavior problems will be informed of the student's behavior record. Any teacher or counselor who is provided this information shall maintain its confidentiality and shall not communicate it to any other person.
