

Professional Staff Training, Workshops and Conferences

The Board desires its professional staff to stay abreast of current trends and developments in education, therefore the annual budget of the district shall provide a specified amount for school visitations, training, conferences and conventions.

Employees authorized by the administration to represent the school system at such educational meetings shall be allowed expenses to include registration fees, mileage, lodging, and necessary meals to a maximum amount set annually by the Board. Additionally the Board shall allow up to two days for pay of a substitute.

Employees shall be expected to share the benefits they receive for attendance at educational meetings with other staff members as deemed appropriate.
